

## **Adult Ceramics Frequently Asked Questions**

**Why should I take a ceramics class at the South Bend Museum of Art?** The museum has a long history of welcoming community artists into our ceramics studio. You get to be part of this community of creative people, and have the opportunity to learn life long skills. You can develop not only a love for art and art history and visual communication skills, but also empathy for the creative abilities of others. A one of a kind experience in an art museum setting. The chance to discover a new journey in clay.

**What can I expect out of a 8 week ceramics class?** A one of a kind experience within one of the only community ceramics studio spaces in Michiana. A hands-on opportunity to explore a 3-dimensional medium, and exposure to the entire process from creation to glazing and firing. **How do I sign up for a ceramics class?** From the Education page on the main website [www.southbendart.org/education](http://www.southbendart.org/education), choose Adult classes, click on Ceramics button. You will be directed to several class options.

**What days and times do you offer classes?** We offer classes Monday to Thursday evenings, some weekday mornings and afternoons.

**Do you offer beginner classes?** Most of the instructors will work with beginning students. It is a good idea to call or email the Studio Program Manager to discuss the best class options for you.

**Can I gain access to the studio if I haven't taken a class?** We prefer that you first take a class with the institution so you can learn how our particular studio functions before you begin working in the studio.
