The South Bend Museum of Art in association with DTSB & the City of South Bend are pleased to present Festival of Banners 2020:

WOMEN: NOW & THEN. Festival of Banners promotes art in the community by bringing art to the public, providing an exciting venue for artists, celebrating community spirit, enhancing the visual environment of downtown streets, and highlighting SBMA's artistic involvement. All ages and skill sets are encouraged to enter.

design.

All entries must be your own design. Works will be selected based upon creativity and how well the theme, **WOMEN: NOW & THEN** is explored and expressed.

Content

This year's theme, **WOMEN: NOW & THEN** comes as we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment, granting American women the right to vote, and nearly half a century after the founding of the Women's Movement in the United States. Women have played a huge role in the creation of our everyday lives. This year's theme calls for reflection on the women who have shaped our lives personally or in their service to society, through history, literature, science, art, and even what women will do far into the future.

Format

dimensions: 4.25 in wide x 10 in high
design submitted on card stock
vertical designs only
no letters or numbers in design

The design must be on card stock, 4.25 inches wide by 10 inches high. Please make design vertical. This format is necessary to project the drawing onto the banner. Your design should be considered finished artwork and colored in the manner you intend the larger design to be colored.

Simple designs using bold, solid colors are the most effective. Letters and numbers are **not** allowed on the banners due to technical reasons.

Entry Fee

\$8.00 per banner (Children 12 & under fee waived & Schools entry fee waived).

Submission Details

All designs & entry forms must be submitted to the museum office by mail or online no later than **5:00 pm, April 27, 2020.** To submit online visit the following link:

*Please note *not all* entries will be accepted. Children should be at least 8 years of age.

*Additionally, designs submitted in the wrong format will not be accepted.

Entries chosen by the jurors will reflect the wide diversity of community participants.

All banners will become the property of SBMA. However, participants can pick up their banners after November 1st. Banners will be stored on

museum property for only 6 months, after which they will be discarded. Please contact us if you have any questions.

Your name, address, telephone number, and the title of the piece must be written on the back of the design card. A completed entry form must accompany the design card. Entry forms, design and fee can be dropped off in person or mailed to:

Upon Selection

If your design is chosen by the selection committee, you will be contacted to schedule a date to paint your banner at the SBMA studio.

To transfer your design onto the banner, the design is projected and then traced with charcoal. This is usually done prior to the day you are scheduled to paint. The transfer process is done by SBMA.

The banner must be painted on both sides. All painting materials are supplied.

We recommend a commitment of at least two full sessions to complete one banner.
